RULES FOR PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE MEMBERS IN THE DISCHARGE OF THEIR FUNCTIONS

- S.O. 609(E).—In exercise of powers conferred by clause (a) of Sub-section (2) of Section 22 of the All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987, (52 of 1987), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:—
- 1.0 Short title and commencement.—1.1 These rules may be called the All India Council for Technical Education (Procedure to be followed by the Members in the Discharge of their functions) Rules,—1992.

- 1.2 They shall come into force on he date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2.0 Definitions:—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires
 - 2.1 "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Council:
 - 2.2 "Secretary" means the Member—secretary of the Council.
 - 2.3 All such words and expressions used in these rules but not defined herein thoughdefined in the All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987 shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them that Act.
- 3.0 Addresses of the Members.—The Council shall keep a register of the members with their full addresses and it shall be incumbent upon the member to keep the Council posted about their latest addresses.
- 4. 0 Ex-Officio Members.—A person who is a ex-officio member shall cease to be a member of the Council from the date from which he relinquished charge of the office by virtue of which he is the member of the Council and it shall be incumbed upon him to infrom the Council about it immediately.
- 5.0 Meetings:—5.1 A member shall attend the meetings of the Council, save where a leave dabsence has been granted by the Chairman in wring, and sign the attendance register kept in meetings.
- 5.2 A A member shall have the right to vote any issue arising in the meeting.
- 5.3 A member shall acknowledge the receipt the Agenda proceedings of all the meetings of Council.
- 6.0 Business of the Council:—6.1 A member shept himself conversant with the provisions of Act and the rules and regulations framed the under and shall also keep abreast of the function of the Council as enumerated under the Act taken up by the Council from time to time.
- 6.2 A member shall assist the Council in charging its functions by providing his technical pertise and advice with a view to enabling Council to take the decisions.
- 6.3 A member shall assist the Council whenecessary by
 - (a) accepting the nominations on expert of mittees;
 - (b) visiting the institutions and organisable as and when deputed by the Council;
 - (c) preparing and submitting reports at such visits.
- 7.0 General Conduct.—7.1 A members shall hold the confidence reposed in him by the Connect shall not divulge any information to any who is not authorised to receive such information.
