**Subject: Revision of eligibility criteria for admission to B.Arch. Course from academic session 2019-2020.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

As per the AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2019-2020, entry level qualification/eligibility criteria for admission in B.Arch. course of 5 years duration is as under.

Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as mandatory subjects with **50% in aggregate and 50% each subject.**

Or

Passed Diploma examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject having obtained at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) marks in the aggregate.

And

Qualifying NATA (Or) Any other Aptitude Test conducted by Competent Authority of the State Government/UT.

However, it has been brought to the notice of AICTE that anomaly has been noticed in the eligibility criteria as prescribed of Council of Architecture (COA) vide Gazette Notification dated 12.02.2019. which is as follows:

No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate."

The Competent authority of AICTE after reviewing the matter, accorded approval to the amendment in the eligibility criteria for the admission of B. Arch. The revised eligibility criteria is as follows:

Passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as mandatory subjects with 50% in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination.

Or

Passed Diploma examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject having obtained at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) marks in the aggregate.

And

Qualifying NATA (Or) Any other Aptitude Test conducted by Competent Authority of the State Government/UT.

This is applicable from the academic session 2019-20.
