Subject: Clarifications on certain issues/ anomalies pertaining to Qualifications, Pay Scales, Service Condition, Career Advancement Schemes (CAS) et. for teachers and other academic staff of technical institutions (Degree/Diploma) prescribed in 6th and 7th CPC notifications.

Sir/Madam,

You are aware that the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has been established by an Act of Parliament for proper planning and co-ordinated development, regulation and maintenance of Norms and Standards in the Technical Education system throughout the Country. Consequent upon revision of pay scales based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission, AICTE formulated a revision of pay scales and service conditions for degree and diploma level technical institutions in the country. The Govt. of India have decided to revise the pay scales of teachers and other academic staff in degree and diploma level technical institutions and advised AICTE to notify the service conditions of teachers in technical institutions incorporating other related conditions.

Accordingly, a notification has been issued on the revision of pay scales and service conditions for teachers, librarians and physical education personnel in both degree and diploma level technical institutions. The detailed notifications for both degree and diploma level institutions had been issued by AICTE on 01st March 2019 and were sent to you sometime in the month of April 2019. These notifications are available on the website of this council and can be downloaded from the links given under for public to see.

Subsequently, this Council has received several representations from faculty/ teachers/ welfare associations and others seeking clarification on issues/ anomalies in the context of the AICTE notification dated 01.03.2019 as per 7th CPC. These issues were under the consideration of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for quite some time. Now, the AICTE Gazette Notification giving clarifications on the subject mentioned above has been published and a copy of the same is put on the website of this Council and the same can be downloaded from the link given below: -

It is also mentioned that All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) issued Regulations, 2019 to regulate Pay Scales, Service Conditions and Qualifications for the teachers and other academic staff in Technical Institution (Degree/Diploma) vide F.No. 37-3/Legal/2010 dated 05th march 2010. Further, AICTE also issued Career Advancement Scheme for the Teachers and other Academic Staff in Technical Institutions (Degree/ Diploma), Regulations, 2012, vide F.No.37-3/ Legal/ AICTE/ 2012 dated 08th November 2012. Subsequent to the issue of above Regulations, the Council received a number of representations seeking clarifications on various issues which were processed and clarifications were published in AICTE Gazette Notification dated 04.01.2016.

After issue of the above clarifications dated 04.01.2016, the Council has again received many representations/ references/ grievances from individual faculty members, teacher associations, State Govt. and other agencies seeking further clarifications on the issues of Pay Scales, Qualifications, Service Matters, Promotions etc. of teachers and other staff. We had also received a number of new cases calling for interpretation/ relaxation from various corners. The clarifications on all the issues are now issued through the Gazette Notifications and a copy of the same is available on the website of this Council which can be downloaded from the link given below: -
